



One of the largest and most popular parks in Singapore, Bishan Park will be redeveloped starting in 4th quarter of 2009.

The 3km - long concrete canal that currently runs along the length of Bishan Park will be transformed into a meandering river, and integrated with the park.

When the redevelopment is completed in 2011, there will be a wider range of leisure and lifestyle options. There will also be wide, open spaces for park visitors to indulge in some quiet relaxation or their favourite exercise.

The two access paths from Sin Ming Ave (car park opposite Blk 407) and Blk 237 Bishan St 22, both leading to Ang Mo Kio Ave 1, will remain open throughout the redevelopment period. Existing business tenants will also continue to serve park visitors.

The canal will be widened and the banks made gentler so that it looks like a natural river. Park visitors will be able to stroll along its banks and even dip their toes into the winding stream.



The cleansing biotope maintains and cleans the water in the ponds by using plants, not chemicals. Water that flows from the biotope will be used for the water playground.

The series of ponds end in a water cascade. A new commercial and plaza area will offer park visitors panoramic views of the park.
