Environmental Impact Study Report

PUB, Singapore's National Water Agency (PUB) has completed a feasibility study and detailed design of the above-mentioned project. This project is required to improve the resiliency of water supply in the western region of Singapore.

Prior to the calling of the construction contract(s), an Environmental Impact Study (EIS) was conducted between 1 April 2020 and 31 March 2021 for two areas where the pipeline route is proposed to be constructed in, namely the forest in NTU and another forest at Southern Tengah. The objective is to establish environmental baseline conditions of the study areas, develop mitigation measures against anticipated impacts from during construction, and to prepare the scope for the Environmental Monitoring and Management Plan (EMMP) during the construction works.

On 11 December 2020, a Nature Group (NG) engagement was held with the Nature Society of Singapore (NSS), Jane Goodall Institute Singapore, NParks, NEA and URA. Their feedback have also been incorporated in the EIS report.
