SEE

See the dam's nine crest gates span all 350m of the mouth of the Marina Channel. Keeping out seawater, it transforms the Marina Basin into a freshwater body. This water, upon further treatment, will be channeled to various locations in Singapore.



TASTE

Taste the waterfront life. The Marina Basin waters are constant all year round, making it the ideal spot for waterfront sports and performances.



TOUCH

Touch the pool of water and watch ripples form at the central courtyard. The central courtyard is a playground for all ages. Get ready for a splashing good time!

RESERVOIR IN THE CITY

1 vision. 20 years incubation. The idea for this unique project surfaced nearly two decades ago, when Minister Mentor Lee Kuan Yew envisioned damming the Marina Channel to create a freshwater reservoir. His compelling vision is realised today in the Marina Barrage. This colossal architectural masterpiece will serve Singapore as a vital water source, act as a barrier to alleviate flooding in the low lying areas of the city and deliver an impeccable waterfront experience.

The Marina Barrage forms Singapore's first reservoir in the city. With a 10,000-ha catchment, the Marina Reservoir stands as the largest and most urbanised of the country's 15 water reserves.

WITHOUT RESERVATION

Interweaving greenery with city chic, the Marina Reservoir, created by the Marina Barrage, gives you the height of technological sophistication in the throes of urban vibrancy.

Singapore's first urban reservoir at the up and coming Marina South district is a must-visit. Walk the vast compounds and come up close with stunning engineering equipment. Visit the Singapore Sustainable Gallery or simply take in the sweeping city skyline from the green roof.

Here, there is room for everything except reservations. The Urban Reservoir Experience awaits.



EXPERIENCE IT ALL!

With so much to see and do at Marina Barrage, here's a checklist of the hotspots to ensure you experience the urban reservoir in full measure.



THE BARRAGE/MARINA BRIDGE

Revel in the refreshing breeze and warm sunshine as you stroll across the Marina Bridge. Watch as water surges into the sea when the crest gates are opened. Alternatively, relax at one of the eight viewing decks overlooking the Marina Reservoir and the panoramic cityscape.

PUMP HOUSE

Check out the gigantic drainage pumps housed at the Pump House. Together, they can empty an Olympic-sized swimming pool in less than 9 seconds!

SOLAR PARK

Visit the largest Solar Park in Singapore covering an area of 1,200 m². The 405 solar panels generate electricity used for indoor lighting and power points in the Marina Barrage.



GREEN ROOF

Stand atop the grass-carpeted Green Roof as the Singapore city skyline greets you.

An eco-friendly feature, the grass helps lower the building's temperature so that less energy is used.

CENTRAL COURTYARD

Soak in the fun at the water playground and have a splashing good time with the younger ones. Or simply chill out at the water fountain area with a refreshing drink.



ARTS TRAIL

Explore the art pieces located around Marina Barrage. The handiwork of local and international artists, all the art pieces revolve around the environmental sustainability theme.



SUSTAINABLE SINGAPORE GALLERY

Learn about Singapore's efforts and achievements in creating a sustainable environment. Filled with fun interactives, a tour of the Sustainable Singapore Gallery will fascinate both young and old. Look out for the Marina Barrage model which demonstrates how the barrage works when there is a heavy storm.
